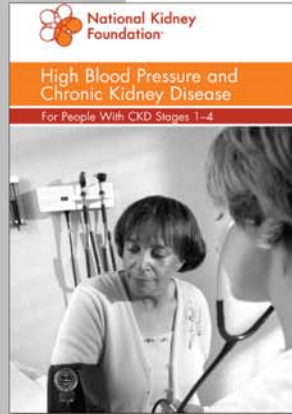

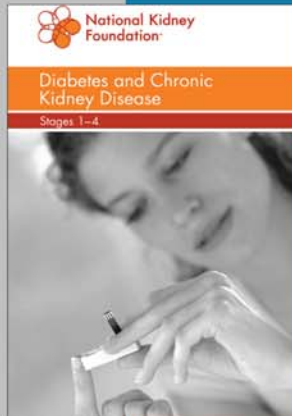
High Blood Pressure and Chronic Kidney Disease
