Monetary Incentive for PQRI Participation

In 2008, incentives for participating in PQRI are at 1.5 percent of your total Medicare billing. In January 2009 the incentives will be 2 percent. For completing CKD measure numbers, we can help add money to your practice.

By simply submitting data to Medicare you may already be collecting and using e-prescribing capabilities, you can earn a total of 4 percent reimbursement as a participant in PQRI. If you are not currently submitting data for PQRI, we can help you begin this process.
