Program Changes for FY 2014 (Handout)

- ◆ **2 New HAI Measures**
- ◆ Collected by CDC via National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) Tool
 - Continue 2011 Requirement to report Central Line Blood Stream Infections (CLABSIs)
 - Begin Catheter-Associated Urinary Tract Infection (CAUTI)
 - Begin Surgical Site Infections (SSIs) in all Colon and Abdominal Hysterectomy surgeries

NHSN Data Submission – CLABSI & CAUTI

- “..CDC-defined designation given to a **patient care** area housing patients who **have similar disease conditions or who are receiving care for similar medical or surgical specialties**. Each facility location that is monitored is “**mapped**” to one CDC Location. The specific CDC Location code is determined by the type of patients cared for in that area according to the 80% Rule. That is, **if 80% or more of the area’s patients are of a certain type (e.g., ICU patients) then the area is designated as that type of location (in this case, an ICU)**.
-Conversely, **if fewer than 80%** of the patients in any hospital unit do **not receive intensive observation**, diagnosis, and therapeutic procedures for critical illness, i.e., **are not ICU patients**, the hospital, by definition, has no ICU location and **is eligible to complete the “Intensive Care Unit (ICU) Location Waiver Form”** consistent with CDC’s “80% rule” and CMS’s Hospital IQR Program policy guidance.
