Created by the Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2015 (MACRA), the Quality Payment Program (QPP) is an enhanced approach to paying physicians and clinicians who care for Medicare beneficiaries. Your practice will choose one of two paths: the MIPS or Alternative Payment Model (APM).
